SUMMARY JOB DESCRIPTION

Chief of Staff

Senior, uniformed SCC, RN, RNR or RM.

RYA Yachtmaster Offshore. Adult management experience. Good communication skills. Active. Accessibility to Walton on Naze.

Take charge of the motivation and ongoing training requirements of all junior uniformed staff. Provide “hand holding” through the joining process for all new staff applicants. Organise team-building and motivational events for all staff. Act as Officer in Charge in the absence of the Commanding officer.

Duke of Edinburgh’s Award Officer

Uniformed or non-uniformed.

Good administrative and presentational skills. Ideally have accessibility to Walton on Naze.

Administration of the DoE Award for the school. Recruit and appoint new Award Groups. Motivate and supply existing Award Groups. Promote the Award to course participants. Organise adult training for supervisor, assessor, and leader roles. Promote the Award to all instructional staff. Liaise with the Award at a Regional level.

Navigation Officer

Uniformed SCC, RN, RNR or MN.

RYA Yachtmaster (offshore or shorebased), RN Bridge Watch keeping or STCW95. Ability to successfully complete RYA Shorebased Instructor one day course. Mobility.

Provide a focal point for the school in all matters pertaining to navigation. Act as Principal of London Area College of Navigation. Deliver 1 x RYA Day Skipper Theory and 2 x RYA Basic Navigation and Safety courses to cadets or staff per year. Maintain the school’s inventory of navigation training equipment. Liaise with the Royal Institute of Navigation.

Development Manager**

Uniformed or non-
uniformed

Minimum RYA Day Skipper
Practical. Dinghy or yacht racing
experience would be helpful.
Accessibility to Walton on Naze.

Develop and manage a female cadet racing squad to crew
the school's racing yachts for eventual participation in club
races, local racing series and regattas.

Offshore Power Skipper

Uniformed or non-
uniformed.

RYA Yachtmaster Power, or
Offshore (sail) and able to convert.
Accessibility to Walton on Naze.

Take command of the school's offshore motor cruiser on a
regular basis. Assist in the maintenance of the vessel.
Work with the Fleet Operations Officer to ensure vessel
availability for training operations.

**Keelboat Skippers and
Trainee Skippers**

Uniformed or non-
uniformed.

Dinghy Sailing Level 2 or Stage 3, or
RYA Day Skipper Practical.
Accessibility to Walton on Naze.

Assist in delivering keelboat training to all keelboat course
participants under the direction of the Training Officer.

Female Cover (Shore)

Uniformed or non-
uniformed.

Enthusiasm to get "stuck in".
Nautical knowledge and enthusiasm
for boating advantageous.
Accessibility to Walton on Naze.

Provide female support on shorebased courses to facilitate
and maximise the participation for female cadets.
